TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FEES

On recommendation from the ASA, and in line with other clubs, Blythe Barracudas charge an annual membership fee. This fee is £20.00 payable on joining the club and annually on 1st January each year. This fee is compulsory and covers insurance, both at poolside and galas, ribbons, trophies, printing, postage, consumable items, along with the swimmers ASA registration fee (squad swimmers who are entered into a league may have to pay an additional fee to the ASA).

There is a voluntary annual membership fee for parents at a cost of £10 which again covers poolside insurance. Please ask for a PINK ASA form if you wish to become a member.

Session fees are paid monthly, at the beginning of each month, by standing order. For new members, fees are due after their 1st full session and can be paid by cheque or cash until the standing order is in place. Session fees are non-refundable, unless there are extenuating circumstances such as a prolonged period of illness (a doctors note may be required) and are at the discretion of the Committee.

CLUB KIT

Club kit is available to purchase and a full list is posted on the website. Minimum kit needed for training will be FINS, KICKBOARD, PULL-BUOY and HAT. Those competing in galas will also need to purchase CLUB SWIMSUIT/TRUNKS, CLUB HAT, CLUB T-SHIRT, CLUB BAG. Please note that, once a purchase has been made, refunds can only be given on faulty items. You are very welcome to try on fins/swimsuits etc to ensure that they fit before purchasing.

Please ensure that ALL kit is named. Blythe Barracudas can not be held responsible for lost or damaged kit. Any lost/found items should be reported to the webmaster who can post a notice on the website.

OVER 18's/MASTERS

It is our usual practice to split juniors/seniors/masters (over 18's) into separate lanes. However, on occasions it may be necessary for swimmers to swim in mixed lanes. Should you object to your child swimming in a mixed lane, *please inform the Welfare Officer in writing*. When a swimmer reaches the age of 18 it is club policy for them to be CRB checked.

CLUB OPERATING PROCEDURE

Blythe Barracudas operate an 'open register' system, where a swimmer can pay for either 1, 2 or 3+ sessions and swim them on any day during a given week. Please be advised however, that sessions cannot be 'banked' and carried over to a following week; and where sessions are split into age groups, swimmers MUST attend an age appropriate session.

Please return this form, together with the membership fee, to the Membership Secretary as soon as possible.

A completed Membership Form must be received for each swimmer and failure to do so may result in a swimmer not being permitted to swim.
